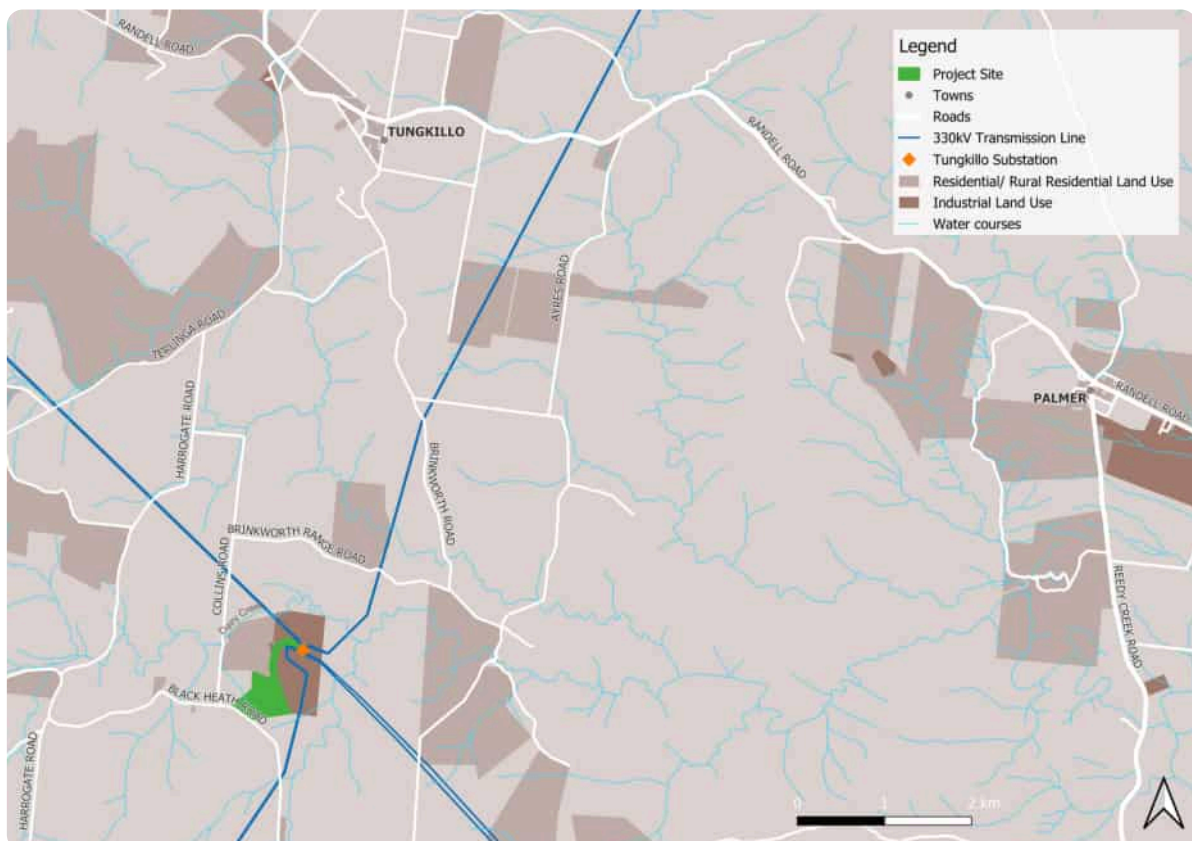
## About Iberdrola Australia
