

Project Update: July – September 2025

Broadsound Solar Farm and BESS

Iberdrola Australia's construction of the Broadsound Solar Farm and BESS is continuing to progress, with multiple areas now under construction.

July to August will include some significant milestones that are critical to the project's success.

Construction and Project Update

The last three months has seen increased activity across multiple work fronts.

The solar farm has seen the completion of the **Golden Rows**, the standard for the installation of all solar farm panel and tracker installations on the project.

Construction on the solar farm has seen significant progress in tracker, panel and underground cabling installation.

Several internal **access roads** have been completed during the last three months.

Earthworks have been completed at the BESS, with the civil works commencing in July.

The **substation** major civil works are nearing completion. Deliveries are ongoing with equipment installation commenced in June.

The **BESS** bench is progressing, with completion due within the next month.

The transmission line tower footings were completed.

Construction activities at the **Powerlink** substation included the completion of the concrete foundation works, and the commencement of the structural and primary plant installation.

Upcoming Works

The next quarter signifies the commencement of all work streams for the project, including the full workforce of around 400 people.

For the solar farm, this includes:

- Tracker installation across the site with the use of additional piling machines
- Majority of the internal access roads completed.
- o Completion of component deliveries.

For the substation, BESS and transmission line:

- Delivery and installation of major substation components. The key dates are:
 - o 23rd July and 6th August: Substation control buildings 1 and 2
 - 15th and 22nd July: Substation transformers delivered under oversized vehicle escort.
- Completion of transmission line, including towers and stringing of overhead conductors. Line string will occur between the 15th – 17th July. This will involve some minor interruptions to Marlborough – Sarina Road for short periods at the direction of traffic controllers.

Powerlink works will involve completing the installation of all primary equipment, and aerial connections that link the equipment to the solar farm and BESS, as well as control cabling installed from the control building to all primary equipment.
