

Retailer Energy Productivity Scheme (REPS): South Australia

What is REPS?

The Retailer Energy Productivity Scheme (REPS) is an energy productivity scheme initiated by the South Australian Government, where [obliged energy retailers](#) such as Iberdrola Australia (Iberdrola) are required to meet an allocated annual energy productivity target. This is achieved by retailers coordinating the provision of eligible energy efficiency activities and products to households and businesses, all with the goal of lowering energy costs and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. The Essential Services Commission of South Australia (ESCOSA) is the organisation regulating REPS.

How does REPS work for Iberdrola?

As an obliged energy retailer, Iberdrola achieves its energy productivity target by partnering with Authorised Certificate Providers (ACPs). ACPs are accredited companies that implement [eligible energy productivity activities](#) and generate energy-saving certificates for energy retailers to meet their REPS target.

What are productivity activities that our ACPs carry out to assist Iberdrola in achieving its REPS target?

For large business customers (non-residential customer with electricity consumption > 160MWh per National Meter Identifier in the 12 months prior to the upgrade):

- Energy efficient lighting

For small-medium business customers (non-residential customers with electricity consumption < 160MWh per National Meter Identifier in the 12 months prior to the upgrade):

- Refrigerated display cabinets
- Water heater upgrades
- Air conditioner upgrades
- Energy efficient lighting

For households customers:

- Energy efficient lighting
- Air conditioner upgrades
- Battery connection to Virtual Power Plant (VPP)
- Water heater upgrades

We encourage you to contact the ACPs referred to below to check your eligibility for productivity activities under REPS. The availability of these activities may vary relative to your location, timing and can be subject to changes without prior notice.
